- The exhibition ships to Prague in March, 2015.
- Load in at Saint Anne's Church begins June 11, 2015.
- PQ opens June 15, 2015.
- PQ closes June 25, 2015
- Exhibition opens at USITT National Conference, Salt Lake City March, 2016
